

Customer fees and deductible of service vouchers (income limit) will change from 1st of March 2023

The table below shows the new minimum income limits (gross) and maximum income limits (gross) 1.3.2023.

If the family size is more than six the income limit on which the payment is based is increased by EUR 197 per minor child.

The maximum payment still is 295 euros on March 1, 2023, and no monthly fee of less than 28 euros will be charged. The fee charged for the second child is a maximum of 40% of the fee for the youngest child. The fee for the following children is 20% of the fee for the youngest child.

Payment decisions are now made with the Income information in the system. Decision making starts in week number 5 and decisions are delivered to the eAsiointi or mailed to your home. Free decisions (€0.00/month) will not be made again, unless the customer reports a change in income. The notification obligation rests with the customer.

It is the customer's responsibility to notify if the income information has changed. A client has always to make a new income declaration if there is an essential change in a family's ability to pay. The client fee has to be verified when family conditions related to determining the fee change or early childhood education period changes.

Decisions that have accepted the highest payment remain valid until the customer himself notifies a change request and submits income information or permission for use by the Income Registry.

The change applies to all municipal daycare customers and also service voucher customers (Musikatti, Touhula, Enkkutarha, Rauma-Repola daycare center, Pikkunorssi).
