

## **When the lease ends, it's also time to move out**

As a rule of thumb, you should remember that after the move-in cleaning, the surfaces of the apartment clean of loose particles and pinning.

### **Walls and tiles**

Wipe the walls of the apartment clean of spills and other dirt. Also wipe the light switches their surroundings clean. Use the extension arm to remove dust and dirt from the back of the radiator

If necessary, wipe the outside of the radiator clean. Wash the bathroom walls and floor

kitchen tiles, especially the seams. If there is red mold on the bathroom walls, wash the walls thoroughly with a disinfectant detergent and a brush. Also remember to clean the shower wall. If necessary, use the extension arm to wipe the bathroom ceiling.

If you do not know which cleaning method the walls of the rooms can withstand, neutral detergent to a more distant place before starting the wash, will the surface last?

### **Doors**

Wipe the door surfaces and the handle clean. Pay special attention to contact surfaces, gets dirty easily (around the handle, etc.).

### **The windows**

If it's not freezing outside, wash all the surfaces of the windows. If it's freezing outside, the outer surface needs to be washed. When washing the window, wipe the frames and window sills. after washing the window, possible splashes from the windowsill, frames and the window from the wall.

### **Floor**

Vacuum the floor and wipe / wash it with appropriate methods, taking into account the dirtiness of the floor and the material (cf. floor mat vs. laminate; laminate is washed using as little water as possible). Also wipe the floorboards.

### **Cabinets**

Clear out the cupboards. Wipe the cabinets clean from all interior and exterior surfaces. Cabinet doors are wiped clean. Remember to also clean the garbage cabinet and waste containers in the kitchen.  
Cabinets

Clear out the cupboards. Wipe the cabinets clean from all interior and exterior surfaces. Cabinet doors and handles are wiped clean. Remember to also clean the garbage cabinet and waste containers in the kitchen.

### **Air conditioning valve**

Remove loose debris from and around the valve. If the valve is removable, remove it by turning it counterclockwise and pulling it out and clean the valve. You can find more detailed instructions on the website

### **Levels**

Wipe the surfaces clean and, if necessary, soak off stains or stubborn stains.

### **Refrigerators**

Empty the fridge and freezer. Wipe the inside and outside of the refrigerator clean. Defrost the freezer with special care and wipe clean when empty. Do not use a knife when melting or let the ice melt on the floor. Clean the doors and handles.

### **Stove / oven**

Clean the stove surfaces. If the stove has cast iron plates, please make sure they are dry after washing to prevent rusting. Clean the controls and pulls. Clean the inside of the oven. Clean the oven grate and trays if necessary. Clean the equipment box intended for storing baking trays. Pull the oven out of the cavity and also clean its outer surfaces as well as the wall surfaces and the floor under/behind the oven.

### **Cooker hood/fan filter**

Wash the filter of the cooker hood or fan. Also wipe the surfaces and the glass.

### **Sink and taps**

Wash the sink. When washing the bathroom sink, remember to also wash its underside, where dirt often accumulates. Clean the sink faucet and remove any limescale. Also wipe clean the shower head and its hose, as well as any soap holder.

### **Toilet seat**

Wash the outside and inside of the toilet seat. Wash the seat from all surfaces. Wash too under the water inlet edge. Clean the foot part of the pot.

Toilet water or odor lock

Clean and empty the odor trap.

Floor drain, Clean the floor drain.
